

PLEASE BRING THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS WITH YOU TO YOUR SCHEDULED APPOINTMENT. COPIES WILL BE MADE.

You can still attend your appointment if you are missing documents.

- **Name and Date of Birth for everyone in the household**
- **Social Security Numbers for each applicant**
- **Photo Identification for each applicant and parent/guardian**
 - Valid driver's license
 - State ID card
 - Student ID
 - Military ID
- **Proof of U.S. citizenship for each applicant**
 - State-issued birth certificate
 - Certificate of citizenship
 - U.S. passport
- **Proof of immigration status for each applicant**
 - Alien registration card, permanent resident card, or other documentation from the Bureau for Citizenship and Immigration Services
- **Proof of money received by applicant, spouse, and dependent children in home for the past 90 days**
 - **Wages**—pay stubs, paychecks, or statement from your employer for the past 90 days
 - **Self-employment**—last year's signed income tax return and personally self-kept records of monthly income and expenses for the past 90 days
 - **Child Support, Social Security Benefits, Veterans Administration Benefits Supplemental Security Income, Workers' Compensation, disability, sick pay, unemployment, or any other received benefits**
 - **Loans, gifts, or contributions**—promissory note, loan agreement or statement from the person providing money that includes the person's name, address, phone number, signature, and date
 - **Financial aid award letter for current year**—only if applicant is currently enrolled in college and receiving any grants or financial aid
 - **Termination notice**—if loss of employment has occurred in the past 90 days
 - **Hire notice**—if employment has been shorter than 90 days
- **Proof of Residency**
 - Lease Agreement
 - Utility or Medical Bill
- **Guardianship or Power of Attorney**—provide documentation if someone has legal authority to act on your behalf
- **Insurance card**— for applicants currently covered by another plan
